Duties and responsibilities

- The position entails teaching and supervision on the Bachelor in CG Art and Animation
- The position involves research and development, including dissemination
- Participation in the development of externally funded research projects will be expected, as well as furthering research collaborations with national and international partners
- It is assumed that the appointee will contribute to the development of the academic community in the faculty, together with other colleagues

About the position

At the Faculty of Social Sciences there is a vacancy for a 100% position at our campus in Levanger, and we are seeking an Associate Professor/Assistant Professor to support the CG Art and Animation programme.

If there are no qualified applicants for the position of associate professor, the faculty may decide to hire at the assistant professor level. In this case, the incumbent will be expected to qualify as associate professor within a period agreed with the Dean. The position is located in Levanger. Nord University faculties are distributed over several campuses, so co-operation between faculty regardless of geographical location is important. The position may involve tasks at Nord University's other campuses.

Position description:

Nord University has a strong position within education in the creative field with bachelor degrees within Film and TV Production, CG Art and Animation, Games and Entertainment Technology, Music, Theatre Production and Acting.Our international media studies are located at our campus in Levanger and are delivered in English. As such, the position requires good oral and written English language skills. We seek an Associate Professor/Assistant professor to design and deliver curriculum content and courses to our students and increase our artistic research within the area of CG Art and Animation.

Personal Qualities:

Successful candidates will be expected to play a prominent role in the development and delivery of the University's study programmes, and to undertake high quality artistic research leading to national and international distribution and/or publication. They will also be expected to positively participate in University activities, proactively contribute to the development of the University's profile in teaching and research, to engage with industry and to undertake administrative, management and leadership duties related to the position.

The profile of the study programs and the research is artistic work. This requires a close cooperation with financing bodies, researchers from other fields, departmental managers and relevant industry. We therefore need a candidate with good communication skills including behaviour and team building qualifications.

Qualification requirements

Associate Professor:

There are two alternative ways to qualify for a position as an associate professor in this subject area:

- Norwegian doctoral degree in the subject area concerned or a corresponding foreign doctoral degree recognized as equivalent to a Norwegian doctoral degree or competence at a corresponding level documented by academic work of the same scope and quality
- Documented competence in relevant educational theory and practice based on training or on teaching and supervision

or

- Completed recognized programme of artistic development in the subject area concerned or documented artistic activities or development work at a high international level and with a specialization relevant for the subject area or discipline
- · Documented competence in relevant educational theory and practice based on training or on teaching and supervision.

Assistant Professor

There are two alternative ways to qualify for a position as an assistant professor in this subject area:

- Higher (master's) degree from a university, university college or the equivalent
- · Relevant research qualifications above the level of a higher degree and/or relevant professional practice
- · Documented competence in relevant educational theory and practice based on training or on teaching and supervision

or

- Documented recognized artistic activities or development work of a certain scope, and
- Education at the highest level in a field of art from Norway or equivalent education from abroad or equivalent documented knowledge, and
- Documented competence in relevant educational theory and practice based on training or on teaching and supervision.

For employment in a permanent position, applicants must be able to teach in Norwegian/Scandinavian language. Temporary employment for two years can be considered in order to obtain ability to teach in Norwegian/Scandinavian language. Applicants who lack documented competence in relevant educational theory and practice will, if hired, be required to obtain the necessary educational training within two years.

Qualified applicants will be ranked according to the following criteria:

- Artistic or academic research and development relevant to the position
- Artistic portfolio/showreel with breakdowns and, if relevant, up to 10 academic publications, journal articles, published media etc
- Experience with international artistic networks and externally funded projects
- Experience in teaching and supervision at Bachelor and Master levels from higher education institutions
- Pedagogical qualifications
- Relevant teaching experience
- Good skills in communicating and collaborating with students and colleagues
- Personal qualities which can contribute positively to the academic environment

Applicants will be evaluated by an expert committee. Short-listed applicants will be called for an interview and trial lecture. These will be decisive for the appointment.

Application

Applications must be submitted online by 30.03.2022.

The electronic application must contain:

- Cover letter
- Complete CV summarizing information regarding education, previous appointments, industry experience, teaching experience, academic administrative experience, academic and/or prefessional research and pedagogic activities
- Copies of diplomas, transcripts and certificates
- Artistic portfolio/showreel with breakdowns and, if relevant, up to 10 academic publications, journal articles, published media etc.
- · Pedagogical CV and reflection note in accordance with supplementary provisions for educational competence
- Documentation of other activities which the applicant considers relevant to the position and desires to be considered in the assessment.
- · Contact information for 2-3 referees

All documentation to be considered is to be uploaded as attachments to the application.

Complete documentation in electronic form must be submitted by the closing date for applications.

After the application deadline has expired a list of applicants will be published. Note that, in special cases, the identity of particular applicants to a position may be made public even when that applicant has requested that their application be processed confidentially. Applicants requesting an exemption from publication of their identity must explain their reasons for doing so in their application.
