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Postdoctoral Research Fellow position within medical statistics

At the [Department of Mathematics](#), University of Bergen, there is a vacancy for a postdoctoral research fellow position within medical statistics from 01.09.2023. The position is for a fixed term of 3 years with the possibility of up to one year of extension.

About the project/work tasks

We are looking for a candidate with a strong background in statistics, and with research interests within medicine, biostatistics or epidemiology. The position is part of a development of the collaboration between the Department of Mathematics and the medical research groups in Bergen. The successful candidate will be a part of the Statistics and Data science group at the Department of Mathematics, and will also actively engage in research collaboration with the Faculty of Medicine at UiB.

The potential research topics can be associated to the following projects:

- (1) ["Digital technology for personalised management and therapy of hypertensive nephropathy"](#). Funded by Helse Vest, project leader Hans-Peter Marti, Faculty of Medicine, University of Bergen.
- (2) [Single Cell Data-derived European Study for Personalised Management of Chronic Kidney Disease \(CKD\) in Children and Adolescents](#), funded by Norwegian Research council, project leader Hans-Peter Marti, Faculty of Medicine, University of Bergen.
- (3) Active projects in the Statistics and Data Science group at the Department of Mathematics.

Qualifications and personal qualities

- Applicants must hold a Norwegian PhD or an equivalent degree within Statistics, including biostatistics, medical statistics and epidemiology, or another relevant field, or must have submitted his/her doctoral thesis for assessment prior to the application deadline. It is a condition of employment that the PhD has been awarded.
- Experience from data analysis and programming (in e.g. R or Python) is a requirement.
- Experience with supervision and pedagogical competence is an advantage.
- Applicants must be able to work independently and in a structured manner, and have the ability to cooperate with others.
- Applicants must have excellent skills in oral and written English.

Personal and relational qualities, and motivation will be emphasized. Research experience, ambitions and potential will also count when evaluating the candidates.

Special requirements for the position:

- The University of Bergen is subjected to the regulation for export control system. The regulation will be applied in the processing of the applications.

About the position of postdoctoral research fellow

The postdoctoral position is a fixed term position with the primary objective of qualifying the appointee for work in top academic positions. In addition to research, up to 25% of the time comprises obligatory duties associated with teaching, dissemination of results and administration. If the position is extended to be 4 years, up to 10% of the fourth year will be dedicated to teaching, supervision, and dissemination of results. Individuals may not be hired for more than one fixed-term period as a postdoctoral research fellow at the same institution.

For postdoctoral research fellow positions associated with externally financed projects, the completion of the project proposal for the qualifying work, as well as a progress plan, will be developed in cooperation with the supervisor and head of department. In accordance with the Research Council's rules, neither can anyone be hired more than once as an NFR-financed postdoctoral research fellow.

It is a requirement that the project is completed in the course of the period of employment.

We can offer

- A good and professionally stimulating working environment
- Position as postdoctoral fellow (code 1352 in the basic collective agreement) and a gross annual salary of NOK 573 900 (equivalent to pay grade 62) upon appointment. Further increases in salary are made according to length of service in the position. A higher salary may be considered for a particularly well-qualified applicant.

Your application must include

- A brief account of the applicant's research interests and motivation for applying for the position.
- The names and contact information for two reference persons. One of these must be a supervisor for the PhD-thesis.
- CV.
- transcripts and diplomas. If you have not yet completed your PhD degree, please submit a statement from your institution confirming that the thesis has been submitted.
- relevant certificates/references.
- A list of any works of a scientific nature (publication list).
- Up to five academic works in full text, that are to be given special consideration in the assessment of your academic qualifications. This may include articles or selected parts of the PhD-thesis.
