About the job

We are looking for a teacher, or teaching assistant, with qualifications in special needs education to join our preschool. This is a 63% temporary position (3 days a week during term-time and 5 days a week during school holidays). The position is open for immediate appointment and until 31.07.2024. We reserve the right to interview and appoint candidates before the closing date.

The role includes:

- Providing an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant, and differentiated curriculum to children with special educational needs.
- Raising the standards of achievement for these children within the preschool curriculum.
- Setting learning goals, and monitoring, supporting, assessing, evaluating and reporting on each child's progress.
- Overseeing the education and training of children - with physical, emotional, mental, and learning disabilities - who have been allocated resources according to the Kindergarten Act (Barnehageloven).
- Providing support and feedback to parents.
- Participation in open evenings and other events organised by the Preschool or external partner institutions.
- Participation in the realisation of the objectives related to SEND tasks.
- Supervising and training other Preschool staff in supporting children with special needs.

Qualifications

- Preferably a Bachelor in Pedagogy or Special Needs Education with NOKUT recognition.
- Excellent English skills, both written and oral (Minimum B2).

Personal qualities

The preferred candidate:

- Is an excellent classroom practitioner
- Is passionate about inspiring the love of learning in children
- Is open minded, reflective and flexible with the ability to think creatively and take risks
- Has demonstrated skills in building a caring, nurturing and creative learning environment
- Has a collaborative and consultative approach when working in teams
- Has demonstrated skills in building positive relationships with parents
