PHP developer

The IT-department at the University of Bergen is one of the largest IT environments in Western Norway. The department wishes to be a digital leader and delivers a wide range of IT services within development, operation, administration, and user support. We are a knowledge-based and committed organization with participation in exciting activities within the whole of UiB's operations and with broad contact with the users at the university. We have a vast variety of technologies, expertise, and nationalities.

The IT department has approximately 110 employees, in addition to apprentices and part-time students. We emphasize continuous improvement and use the ITIL framework for organizing service deliveries. The department has a product-based approach to all deliveries.

With the increasing need for user-friendly and stable digital solutions for the university, the IT department is looking for a PHP developer (senior engineer/chief engineer) for the Section for digital products and business services. We work together in a team with a wide range of work tasks, and we are looking for a person who can complete our team and strengthen expertise professionally, technically, and methodically. The main tasks for the position are linked to the university's external web, with an upgrade to a new web platform.

Work tasks:

- As a developer, you are part of a product team that works closely together on solutions, either within digital learning services or other services for students and staff.
- Your main task will be to participate in new development and further development of UiB's solutions, both self-developed and off-the-shelf.
- Through dialogue with users and service owners in and outside the department, you and the product team must understand the users' needs and translate them into tasks.
- You and the product team will have the technical responsibility for a solution from concept to operation in consultation with the product owner and in interaction with other relevant IT resources from the department.
- Contribute to further developing the product area and the professional environment at the IT department.

Qualifications and and characteristics:

- Experience with Drupal or Symfony is a requirement. Can perhaps be compensated with extensive experience from other modern frameworks such as Laravel.
- Experience with modern PHP code is a requirement. Knowledge of changes in PHP 8.1, 8.2 is also 8.3 and refactoring of older code is advantageous.
- Competence on the Linux platform for development and publishing is an advantage.
- Experience with container technology such as Docker is an advantage.
- Experience with Git, Composer, Continuous integration (CI), writing unit and integration tests is advantageous.
- Experience with one or more of the following is an advantage: JavaScript, SQL, NOSQL

- Good oral and written communication skills in Norwegian desirable. Excellent communication skills in English are a requirement.
- For senior engineer, the requirement is a master's degree within the relevant subject area. Extensive, relevant practice combined with relevant continuing and further education may, in special cases, compensate for a lack of formal education
- For head engineer, you must have at least a bachelor's degree or engineering education from a university or college. Extensive, relevant practice combined with relevant continuing and further education may, in special cases, compensate for a lack of formal education

We are looking for a person who

- Is a team player who shares expertise and sees the value of doing good for others.
- Takes initiative, is curious and has the ability to acquire the necessary skills.
- Shows interest in finding good and simple solutions in interaction with users, system owners and product owners.
- Enjoys work and has the ability to execute.
- Can work independently, in a structured manner and is quality conscious with an eye for detail.
