The Department of International Environment and Development Studies is looking for a highly qualified and motivated professional to serve as Research Communications Specialist in our newly awarded EU project entitled 'Community-Based Policing in Post-Conflict Police Reform'. The project will last for 5 years, and will involve researchers from 16 institutions from four continents, studying police reform process in 11 case studies. The study will be interdisciplinary and qualitative, involving the participation of a broad set of stakeholders from academia, government and non-government institutions, and civil society.

Within this project, the Research Communications Specialist will be responsible for the design, planning implementation and monitoring of communications between project researchers, as well as for ensuring communication of research activities and findings with a wide variety of audiences using innovative media platforms.

This is a temporary project position for 5 years reporting to the project leader.

The Department carries out research, education and institutional collaboration within international environment and development studies and international relations and offers Bachelor's, Master's and PhD programmes. The Department has an international and interdisciplinary environment with about 50 employees, 40 PhD-Candidates and 275 students.

An administrative staff of about 12 employees are responsible for services within education- and research administration, communication, project management, finances and accounting, human resources and support functions. These services are of outmost importance for the Department to reach its goals within education, research and international cooperation.

The position

Tasks and responsibilities:

- Design, plan, implement and monitor the project communications strategy
- Design and maintain the external website, including content creation
- · Design and maintain the internal project website
- Manage in an efficient manner communications between researchers concerning knowledge generation, research data, findings and dissemination activities
- Manage data files and result sharing between researchers
- Facilitate literature sharing
- Conceptualize and produce online communications and diverse types of publications, i.e. handbooks, flyers, in close communication with researchers
- Handle press enquiries and social media activities
- Proactively engage with stakeholders in communicating research activities and findings.
- Assist in the preparation and conduct of annual meetings and events

Qualifications

- University degree or higher education, minimum a master's degree, in communications, journalism, or other relevant field.
- Experience in managing communications in large scope projects that require coordination across internal and external teams
- Fluent English, with exceptional writing and editing skills in writing both strategically and creatively
- Proven ability to translate complex analysis and ideas into message-oriented, concise and accessible language
- Knowledge of current thinking and practice in research communications
- Expertise in webpage management, multimedia and social media

Desired:

- Higher education or experience in social science research, preferably qualitative
- Knowledge of Spanish
- Interest in the topic of research

Personal qualifications:

 Strong organization, coordination and project management skills, including the ability to manage multiple tasks and processes, to prioritize work independently and to balance competing demands

- A self-starter, able to work well both independently and as a dedicated team member
