## Assistant Professor in Business Economics

The Department has high ambitions in terms of research and offers a stimulating research environment, where the main research activities are organized in three broad areas: Business Economics (BE), Management Science (MS), and Energy, Natural Resources and the Environment (ENE). The position is of four years duration and provides an opportunity to qualify for a permanent position as Associate Professor or Full Professor. Applicants should hold, or be close to completing, a PhD in Business Economics, Economics, Finance or Accounting. Potential candidates should have a strong or a proven potential for high quality research for publication in international journals. In the event of equivalent qualifications, female applicants will be given preference.

Applicants are expected to have a research interest within one of the following two areas:

- Organizational Economics / Corporate Governance / Management Control / Performance Management / Firm Strategy and Pricing Behaviour
- Risk Management / Insurance and Pensions / Capital Budgeting / Valuation

Particular attention will be paid to applicants doing empirical research. The positions involve teaching on an average of one course a year as well as graduate supervision of students.

The salary will be negotiable according to the State Salary Scale for Junior Positions. In addition, we can offer:

- Funds for travel, equipment and other expenses
- Membership in the Norwegian Public Service Pension Fund
- Bonus for publications in selected journals (up to NOK 100 000)
