Researcher under SVALI program at UMB

Applications are invited for a temporary position as researcher (up to 12 months) at the Norwegian University of Life Sciences.

The positions will refer to Cecilie Rolstad Denby, Departement of Mathematical Sciences and Technology, UMB, Ås, Norway.

The candidate will join the Nordic Centre of Excellence (NoCE) project "Stability and Variations of Arctic Land Ice" (SVALI) (https://ncoe-svali.org), supported by the Nordic Top-level Research Initiative. SVALI is a NoCE within the TRI sub-programme "Interaction between Climate Change and the Cryosphere", which aims to improve our understanding of stability, variations and dynamics of the cryosphere.

Main tasks

The candidate will work with modeling of the mass balance of Sørbreen, Jan Mayen. The position will be one of 15-20 SVALI PhD student and researchers located at Nordic research institutes and universities.

Qualifications

The successful candidate must hold a Ph.D. degree in Geophysics, Atmospheric sciences or similar fields. Also, a good background in physics and mathematical analysis as well as good communication skills and an ability to write scientific papers are essential. We wish to appoint a creative and dedicated candidate who is good at pursuing results independently, and at the same time work well in groups.

UMB wants to recruit more women to science. If two or more applicants are considered to be equally qualified for the position, and at least one of them is a woman, the woman will be employed.

Salary

The salary of a researcher is ranked by the Norwegian government salary scale at 57 - 64.

Applicants invited for an interview will be asked to present confirmed copies of diplomas and certificates.
